Our Aboriginal students chose a buddy to attend with them. The day commenced with a traditional Welcome to Country performed by local Aboriginal elder, Gwenda Jarrett. The next activity was building sand sculptures on the beach which everyone really enjoyed. Other activities of the day included Traditional Indigenous games, painting canvases, making beaded bracelets, making dream catchers and the most popular activity was making damper with maple syrup. It is a really important day



for our students as they build connections and create friendships with other students from our Kiama Community of Schools, and the role of the buddy cannot be underestimated.

Ms Berwick stated *“A highlight for me was seeing Wally S. and Ethan K. in Year 1 deciding to go and join in a game run by Savannah D, an ex-student of GPS, and participate with students from other schools and have a really great time. That's what these days are all about, and we are already looking forward to next years' event. A big thank you to all of those who helped organise the day”.*

### *Book Swap*

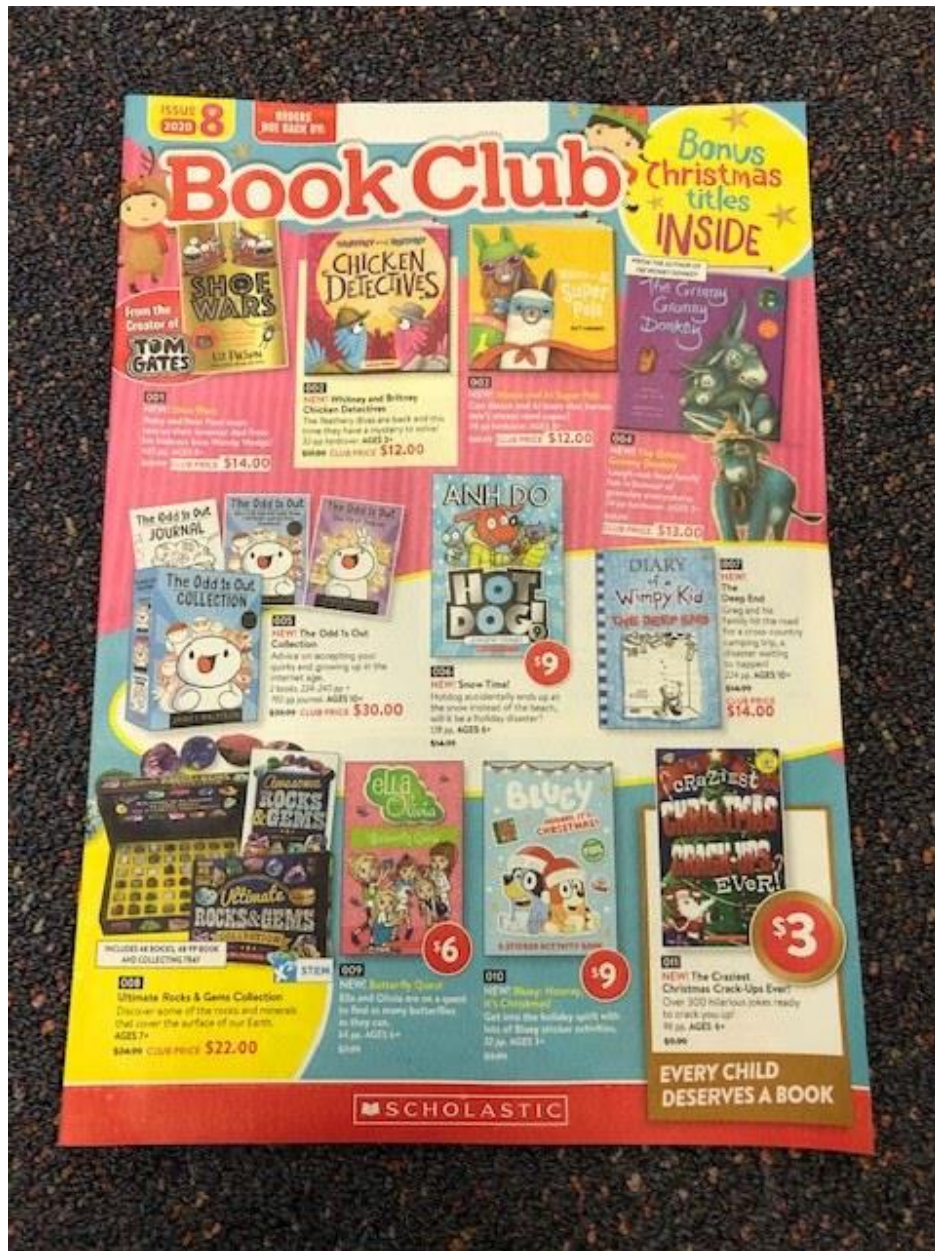
