[Inclusive, Engaging and Respectful \(IER\) Schools package](#)

The Inclusive, Engaging and Respectful (IER) Schools package was announced in February this year by NSW Minister for Education and Early Learning, Hon Sarah Mitchell.

It centres on three new policies and procedures and a framework that together set the guidelines for how we ensure all children and young people can learn through public education in a safe and engaging way. The IER Schools package includes the:

1. Inclusive Education Policy for students with disability
2. Student Behaviour Policy and Procedures
3. Restrictive Practices Framework and Restrictive Practices Reduction and Elimination Policy and Procedures.

With these new policies, we want all students to:

- be included in all aspects of school life and supported to learn to their fullest capability
- be supported in engaging, respectful, and effective classrooms with positive and inclusive practices
- feel welcomed, valued and safe in our schools and classroom

Two of the policies are new: the Inclusive Education Policy; and the Restrictive Practices Framework and policy. Both clarify *existing* legal obligations, effective, appropriate and prohibited practices, and the rights of students, parents and carers. The Student Behaviour Policy replaces the Student Discipline in Government Schools and Suspension and Expulsion Policy. The key change is the approach all NSW public schools will take to address disruptive or inappropriate behaviour by a student. The duration of a suspension will be reduced along with the number of suspensions across a school year. Every school will be able to draw on the support of a range of staff including behaviour specialists to effectively address issues resulting in these behaviours in order to prevent future escalations. We will continue to work closely with you and all our families. It does not mean, however, that students who are violent or seriously disrupt the learning and wellbeing of others will be kept at school. Any student who puts the safety of other students, teachers and staff or visitors at risk of harm – will be suspended until it is safe for them to return. The Inclusive Education Policy for students with disability and the Student Behaviour Policy becomes operational in Term 3, 2022 and the Restrictive Practices Policy becomes operational in Term 1, 2023. The staff and I are reviewing our current approach to all of the areas covered by these policies, and wish to share any changes we believe need to be made with you next term. Our school already takes a strong, positive student-centred approach, but we want to work with you to ensure, together, every student has the right support at the right time to help them grow into confident, resilient adults. Dragons 'The Best You Can Be' health and wellbeing program

The 'Best You Can Be' program, now in its 7th year, has been very successful in supporting teachers to encourage students to make positive choices around health and wellbeing.

In 2021, in total, 104 schools took part in our 'The Best You Can Be' program. Seventy-six (76) schools from our catchment between Undercliffe in the north to Eden in the far south. We also delivered the program digitally to twenty-eight (28) rural and remote schools after receiving expressions of interest, two years ago, from five DEC Country Network Directors to offer the program to their schools.

Included in our 'outreach' program is little Queensland country school Dingo State School. This was Dragon's captain, Ben Hunt's primary school and after noting the success of the program here locally, he was keen to have his old school involved. He now funds the program for Dingo SS.

New Initiative - 2022

Many of the Dragons players, after noting Ben Hunt's initiative, were keen to follow suit. Thus, we now have many of our players giving back to their primary schools and funding their program. A fantastic gesture from the players.

We are pleased and proud to inform you that your school has been nominated by St George Illawarra Dragons player **Jackson Ford**, a former student, who wishes to thank **Gerringong Public School** and all his teachers for their support and guidance in his early development. He is excited about the possibility of giving back to his school as a means of saying thank you!

Jackson will fund the cost of the program and at some stage come and visit and assist in presenting a lesson.
