

















# Drug Education Program











Our regional athletics team also competed in Canberra in the last fortnight.














#### **PSSA Girls Touch Football**




## SASS Week

## Tell Them From Me Parent Survey

The Tell Them From Me Parent Survey is now open and will close on the 20th of September. This survey covers parents' perceptions of their child's experiences at home and at school. Insights into parent and staff communication, activities and practices at home, and parent voice on the school's support of learning and behaviour. This feedback will build an accurate and timely picture that schools can use for practical improvements. Students in Years 4-6 will also complete an anonymous survey to capture their views.

### What you need to do:

- 1. Go to http://nsw.tellthemfromme.com/nnbxq1
- 2. Remember the survey is **confidential**, **voluntary**, and **participants may skip any questions** they are not comfortable answering.
- 3. Only one parent should complete the survey for each child, unless they feel very strongly that their viewpoints are different. In the case of separated parents, we encourage both parents to complete the survey if they have different perspectives.

#### Check-in assessment for Year 6

During Week 9/10 of Term 3, Year 6 students will participate in the Check-in assessment.

The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online literacy and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The assessment can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. Students with a disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment they would normally receive in the classroom.

All students complete a reading assessment and a numeracy assessment. Year 6 students will also complete a writing task

Students will be asked to bring headphones or earbuds that plug into a computer to enable them to hear audio during the assessment.

Mark Allicon mans junior training sessions on Wednesday nights at figm from absolute beginners upwards. He holds current certificates for Squash NSW Junior Training, and Working with Children.

Classes run for approx. 1 hour, and cost is \$10.80 per shilld per session.

We use a WhatsApp Group to communicate with players, so they can see when lossons/events are coming up, or if there are any changes to the plans e.g. holidays.

We put aside a squash court on Sat afternoons from 1-žam for juniors to come down and have a hit between thermalism and practice their short. Cost in \$8,000 per player.
